Parking at the School

It has been brought to our attention that a number of parent/carers have been parking illegally at the back gate of the school. Please be aware that by parking illegally you are putting our students at risk. Below are the definitions of No Parking and No Stopping directly from the RTA Website.

NO PARKING – You may not stop for longer than 2 minutes and only to drop off or pick up passengers or goods (i.e. you must remain within 3 metres of your vehicle).

NO STOPPING - You may not stop your vehicle for any reason.

NO STANDING – Is the same as **NO STOPPING**.

The Parking Officer and the Police have been notified. Please be aware of these laws as illegal parking is a great danger to our children.
