Reminder - Toys at school

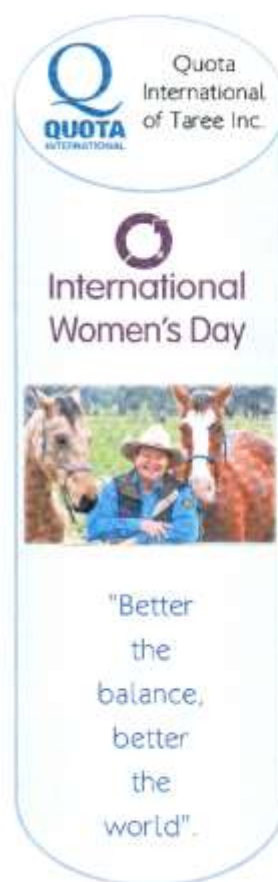
