Student Attendance Procedures

What do I do if my child is late to school?

You will need to accompany your child to the school office for a late note, where you will be asked to provide a reason for their partial absence. If you cannot accompany your child to the office, you are required to ring the school on 6552 1910 to explain the reason for their partial absence. This must be done on each occasion that they are late to school.

What do I do if my child is away from school?

If your child is away from school you must explain their absence within 7 days from the date of the absence. You can do this by ringing the school office on 6552 1910, personally seeing or messaging your child's teacher or sending a note to school when your child returns following their absence. All unjustified absences are monitored and followed up by the school executive staff and the Department's Home School Liaison Officer.

Road Safety in and around the school

Parents/carers are reminded that the staff car parks are for staff only – Due to WHS procedures parents/carers are not permitted to enter the car parks or park in the staff car parks at any time. Parents/carers are also asked to remind their children to use the footpath around the school where available, when entering and leaving the school. Please do not allow your children, or walk with your children, through the staff car parks at any time.

TWPS Cross Country

This year we will be holding both the Infants and Primary Cross Country on the same day.

All students will participate in the cross country in age groups according to the **age they turn this year- 2019**.

The **Infants Cross Country** will commence at **10:00am**. It will involve all **students aged 5, 6 and 7 years old**.

The order of the races will be:

- 5 year old girls / boys
- 6 year old girls / boys
- 7 year old girls / boys

All infants' races will be 1 lap of the cross country track.

It is expected that the Infants Cross Country races will be finished by the start of lunch at 11:10am.

The **Primary Cross Country** will **commence at 12:15pm**. It will involve all students aged 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13.

The order of the races will be:

- 8/9 year old girls / boys
