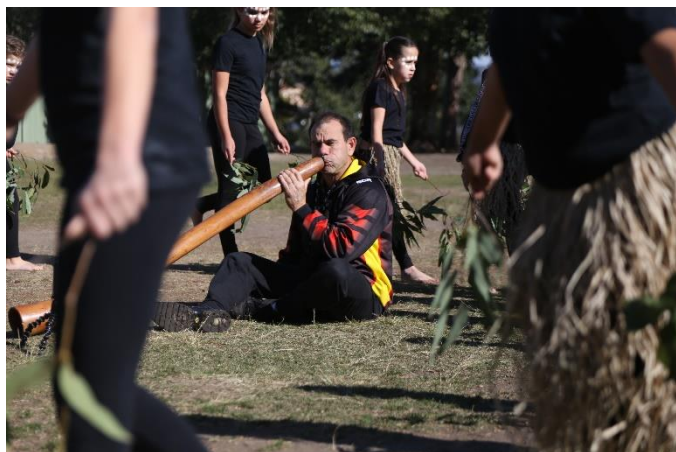
Focus on Learning
