#### Testing

Remember: Staff and students cannot attend school if they are showing any [symptoms of COVID-19](#).

If symptoms occur at any time, your child should not attend school and should undertake a rapid antigen test (RAT).

#### When a family member tests positive to COVID – Can I send my other children to school?

The short answer is Yes – if they do not have symptoms however the following guidelines must be adhered to.

Close contacts attending school will need to adhere to the following in addition to the [NSW Health guidelines](#):

- **They must notify the school (including their outside of school hours care provider) if they are intending to return under this provision.**
- **They must conduct a daily rapid antigen test (RAT) and return a negative result each morning before attending school for 5 school days.** Additional RAT tests are available from the school – Please call the office on 6552 1910.
- **They must wear a mask indoors except when eating or exercising.**

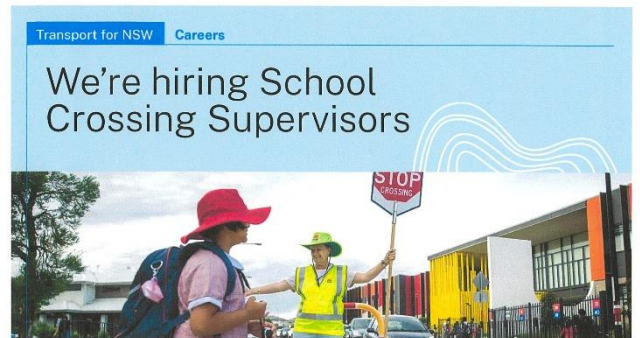
