### **Dear Parents and Carers**

### Is your child unwell?

Our current number of student absences is between 70 and 110 students each day. We seem to be experiencing a spike in student absences, at the moment.

If your child is unwell:

- Keep him/her home whilst they have symptoms and until they are better
- Use the RAT kits to test for COVID
- Please inform the school of the reason for their absence via SMS, through SeeSaw or via phone on 6552 1910.
- Please contact the school if you require more RAT kits

## **Learning Meetings**

Learning meetings are being held at school this week. Our aim is to meet with/talk to all families therefore if you haven't booked in as yet for a meeting, please do so as soon as possible. The meetings can take place over the phone on in person, following COVID safe measures. If you are attending the school for a meeting, you may proceed directly to your child's class at the allocated time.

### 3-6 Assembly this Friday at 2pm

A 3-6 Assembly will be held at 2:00pm this Friday afternoon in the school hall. Parents and Carers are welcome to attend. Entry will be via the OOSH hall gate, visitors will be required to sign in using the QR code and will need to wear a mask.

### **School Uniform**

All students are required to wear full school uniform to school each day, this includes the school hat and jackets/jumpers. Designer jumpers/jackets and hats are not permitted even in school colours. If families need any support with uniform requirements, please contact the school office on 6552 1910 or your child's teacher on Seesaw.

### **COVID Response and Management**

Many of our existing COVID-smart measures continue into Term 3.

Parents/Carers are required to report all COVID positive results to NSW Health and the school. Please call the school on 6552 1910 to report all positive cases or text a reply to the daily SMS absence messages.

### **Testing**

Remember: Staff and students cannot attend school if they are showing any <u>symptoms of COVID-19</u>.

If symptoms occur at any time, your child should not attend school and should undertake a rapid antigen test (RAT).

A multipack of RAT kits has been sent home with all students. Please contact the school office if you require further kits in the coming weeks.

# When a family member tests positive to COVID - Can I send my other children to school?

The short answer is Yes – if they do not have symptoms however the following guidelines must be adhered to.

Close contacts attending school will need to adhere to the following in addition to the <u>NSW Health guidelines</u>:

- They must notify the school (including their outside of school hours care provider) if they are intending to return under this provision.
- They must conduct a daily rapid antigen test (RAT) and return a negative result each morning before attending school for 5 school days. Additional RAT tests are available from the school – Please call the office on 6552 1910.
- They must wear a mask indoors except when eating or exercising.
